“We’ll take you to see Croco Doc so he can treat it!” says Mr. Bull.






Jana's parents arrive immediately and take her to the surgery.

"This will help the bone stay still and heal properly."




He also prescribes her some syrup.

But he's so clumsy that he trips and falls!




The next day, Jana's friends apologise to her.
