So George has started to let his hair grow out.



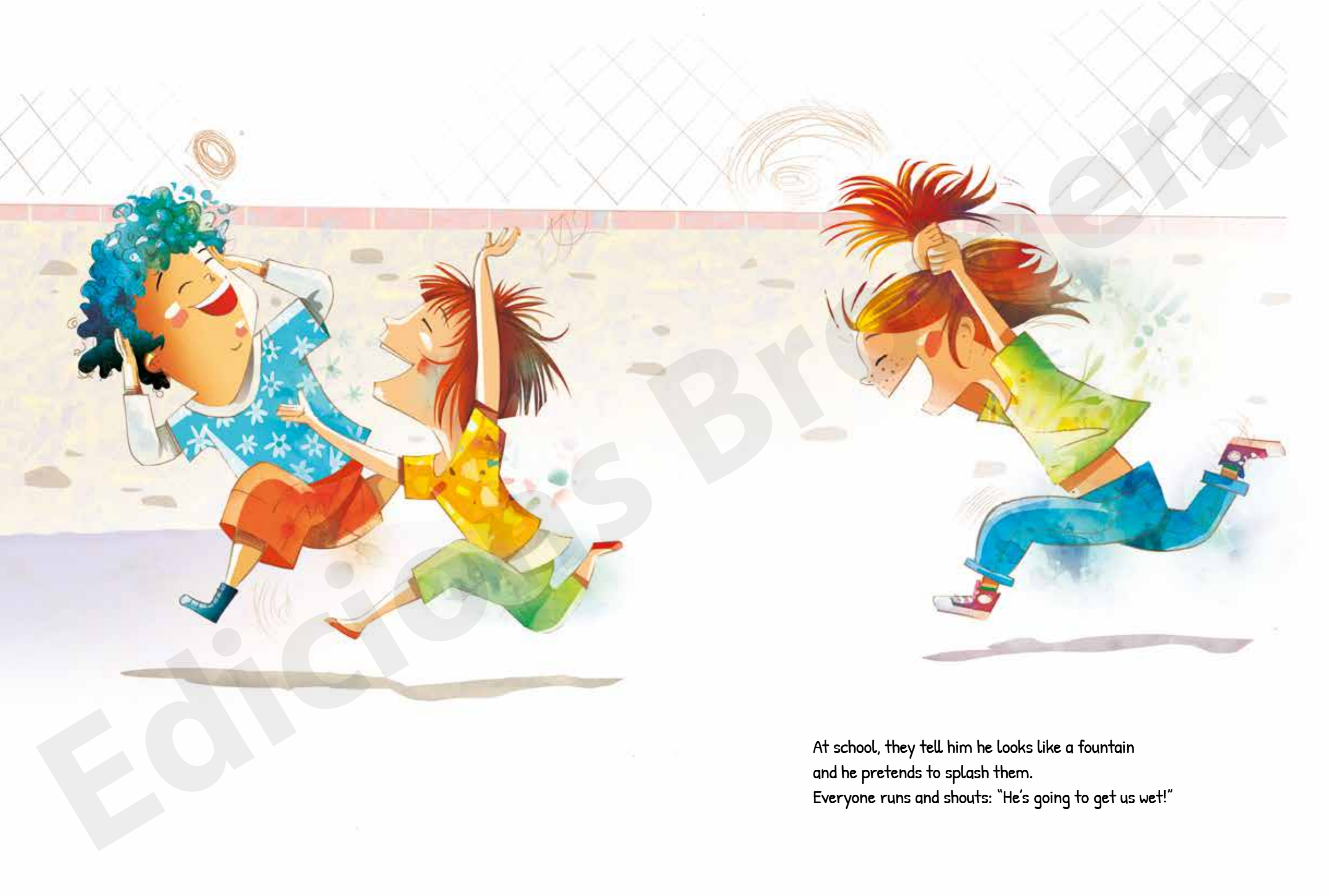
First, it covers his eyes.
