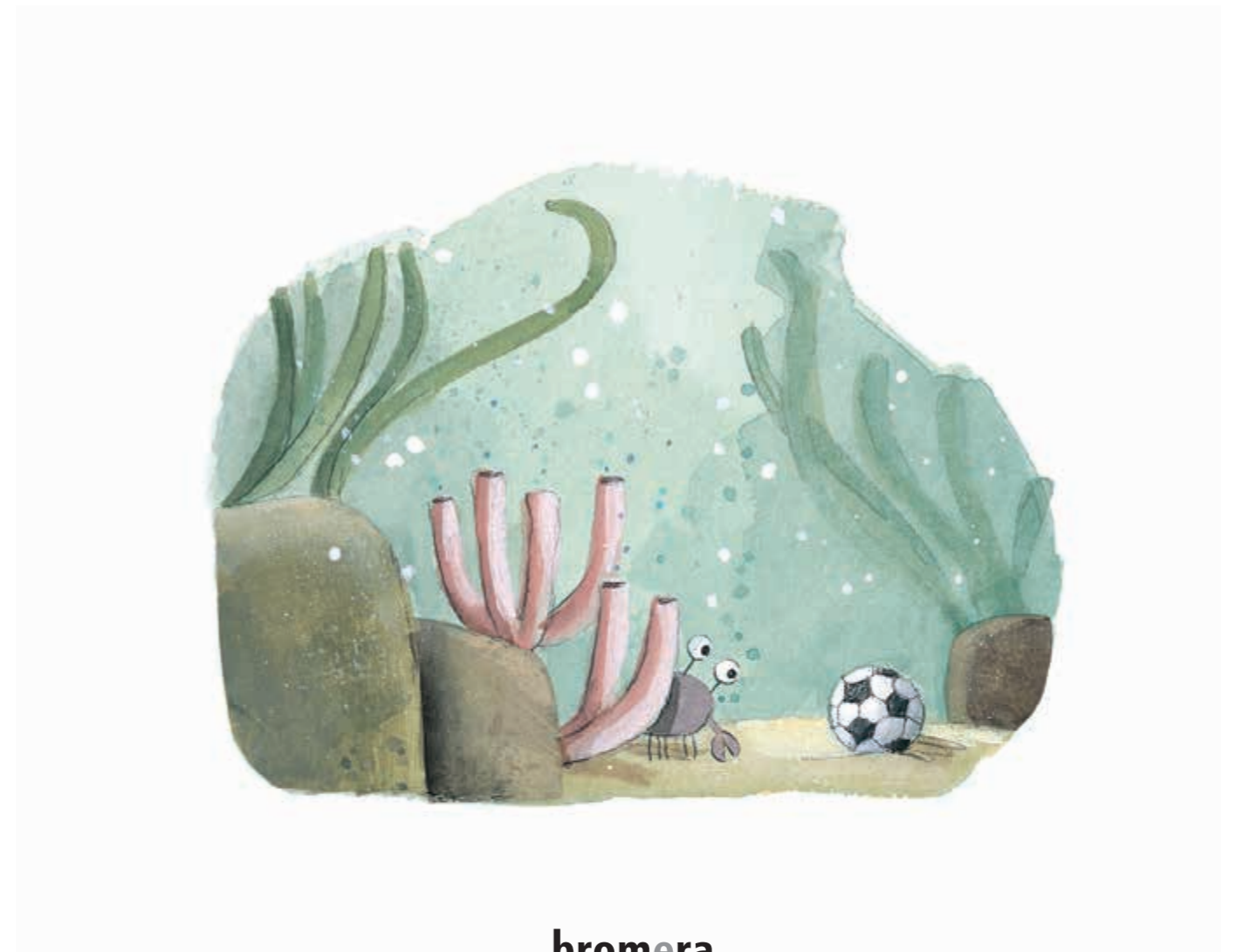

One day a gang appeared and invited him to go with them. Only him.



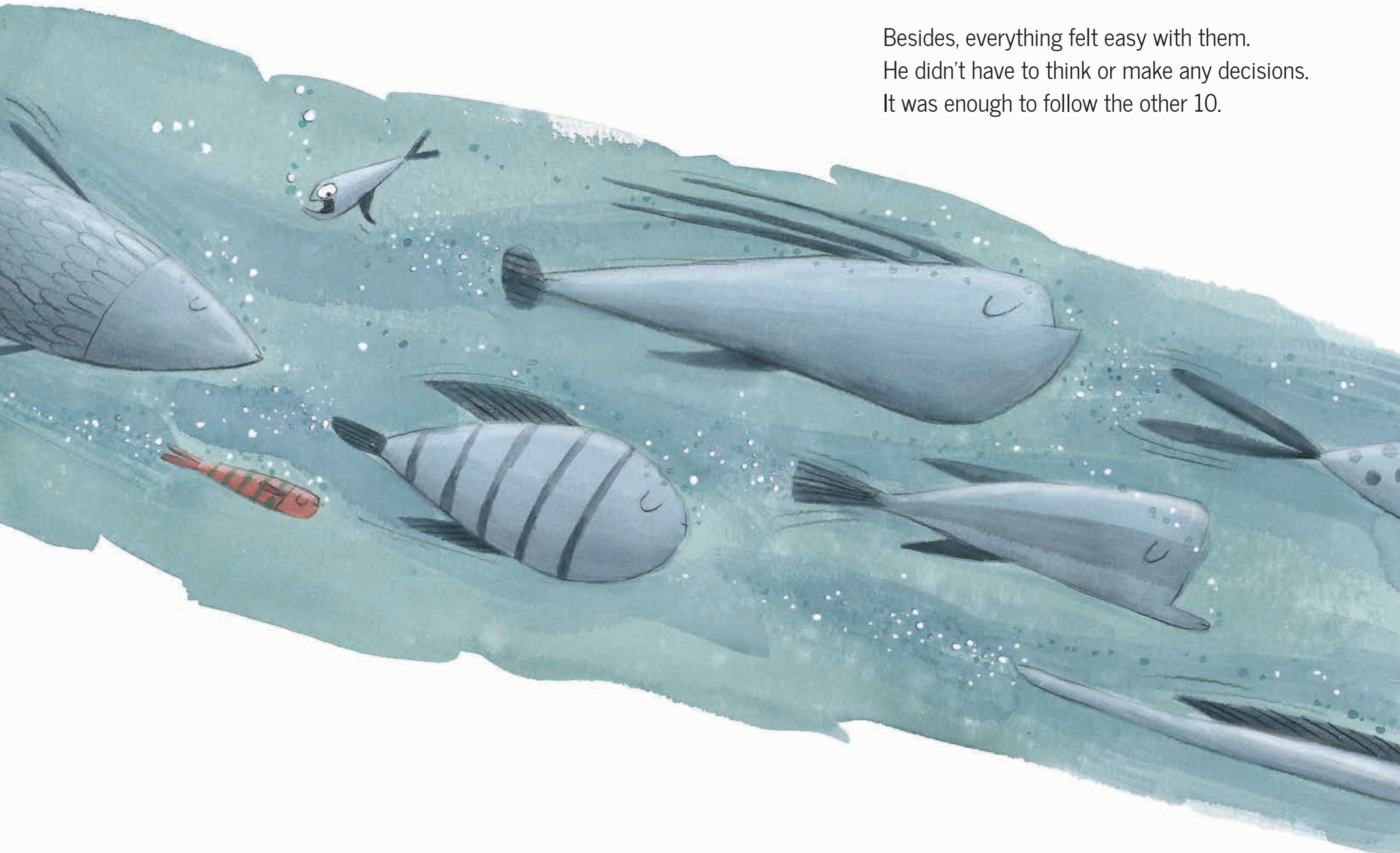
The little red fish was very flattered and, without hardly realizing it, he became the 11th fish of that gang.
